

NOTICE OF RACE

The notation [DP] in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification. The notation [NP] in a rule in the NoR means it shall not be grounds for protest by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. All competitors shall wear a PFD at all times while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This changes RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4. [NP]
- 1.3. RRS 48.2 is deleted.
- 1.4. US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to: 505, Club 420, CFJ, Laser, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, RS Tera, Optimist R/B/W, and Optimist Green boats, whose skipper is a member in good standing of their respective class association. Other one design dinghy classes are invited to contact the StFYC Race Office by 10/11/19 for possible inclusion in the regatta.
- 2.2. Participants in the Club 420, Laser 4.7, RS Tera, and Optimist classes are required to be members of BAYS, which is free.
- 2.3. Eligible boats may enter by submitting the entry form and paying the entry fee online www.stfyc.com. An entry is not considered complete until the entry fee has been paid. All entry fees on or after 10/23/19 are non-refundable.
- 2.4. Classes must have a minimum of six boats registered by October 23 in order to qualify for a class start.
- 2.5. Entries received on or after October 23 will incur a late fee in accordance with SI 3.

4.2. Six races are scheduled for all classes.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at or before the competitors' meeting and may also be available online (www.stfyc.com).

6. RACING VENUE & COURSES

- 6.1. Race Venue 1: City Front, north of StFYC
- 6.2. Race Venue 2: Ft Mason Cove, east of the SF wave attenuator
- 6.3. The course may be a windward leeward or any variation of a triangular or other course. Course diagrams will be provided in the sailing instructions.

7. SCORING

- 7.1. One race will constitute a series.
- 7.2. When four (4) or fewer races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 7.3. When five (5) or more races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes RRS A2.

8. BERTHING

Boats shall be kept on the grass island located to the east of the St. Francis Yacht Club clubhouse. [DP]

9. PRIZES


Prizes will be awarded based on participation.

BOAT & TRAILER STORAGE
