## 1 Rules

### Notice of Race

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020, the prescriptions of US sailing, the Class Rules, the BAYS (Bay Area Youth Sailing) Notice of Series
- 1.2 The PFD referred to in RRS 40 must meet US Coast Guard Requirements and must be inherently buoyant with an attached whistle.
- 1.3 All boats shall have an attached floating line capable of towing the boat on the water (minimum - 1/4" diameter, and 15 feet long, C420 follow class rules attached to a towing point while racing
- 1.4 All boats shall carry a bailer, except the Laser Radials and RS Tera

## 2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The Santa Cruz Yacht Club and Santa Cruz Junior Sailing Program, invite all youth sailors to this regatta. This regatta is open to C420, CFJ, Laser Radial, Opti Championship, Opti Green, and RS Tera
- 2.2 Participants are required to be members of BAYS <https://theclubspot.com/join/mYcYxrwBRX/overview>
- 2.3 Each sailor shall be under 20 years of age during the entire series and shall not have graduated from high school, or its equivalent to be eligible to participate.
- 2.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form and paying the entry fee online at <https://theclubspot.com/regatta/F0uxv12Bsy/class> on or before 11/12/19 to avoid late fee penalties.
- 2.5 When checking in Saturday, 11/16/19, the participant and parent/guardian will also need to sign the waiver (Or bring a signed copy).
- 2.6 Classes must have at least 3 boats registered by 11/13/19 to qualify for a start.

- 4.2 The Race Committee will start as many races as practical each day.
- 4.3 No warning signal will be made after 1530 hours on Sunday the 17<sup>th</sup>.

## 6 Venue

- 6.1 Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys within a 1.00-mile radius from the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty. Trapezoid or Windward-Leeward-Triangle courses may be used.
- 6.2 The regatta will be held off the Santa Cruz Beach by the Boardwalk in relatively open water that is typically in the mid 50 degree temperature range with typical wind in the 8-25 knot range. Competitors should dress appropriately. Wet suits or dry suits are strongly recommended.

## **7 Courses**

7.1 Course diagrams will be distributed with the sailing instructions.

## **8 Scoring**

8.1 One race will constitute a series.

8.2 When four or fewer races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

8.3 When five or more races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes RRS A2.

## **9 Berthing**

9.1 Boats shall be kept in the Santa Cruz Yacht Club dry boat storage for rigging, de-rigging and overnight. Link to Map of Santa Cruz Harbor [http://www.californiasbestbeaches.com/twin\\_lakes/santa\\_cruz\\_harbor.html](http://www.californiasbestbeaches.com/twin_lakes/santa_cruz_harbor.html)

9.2 Safety and Coach Boats will be keep overnight on Saturday on the dock under the Santa Cruz Yacht Club hoist between D & E dock.

9.3 Trailers parking is limited if needed some road trailer may have to be taken offsite.

10.1 Prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

10.2 An awards ceremony will take place at the clubhouse after racing on Sunday.
