



# NOTICE OF RACE

## Frozen Assets

February 15 & 16, 2020

### ROYAL VICTORIA YACHT CLUB

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. The applicable One Design Class Rules will apply.

#### 2. ADVERTISING

Boats and sailors may be required to wear and/or display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

#### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to one-design dinghies as well as 2.4 meter keelboats. In order to compete, Sailors must be a minimum of 7 years old as of Feb 15, 2020. This follows recommendations by BC Sailing for Circuit events. We anticipate classes to include Fireball, 29er, 420, Laser, Radial, 2.4meter and Optimist. Competitors in the Optimist class are assigned to fleets as follows:

**Ages are as of December 31 of the current year.**

**Red** – age 13 - 15

**Blue** – age 11 or 12

**White** – age 10 or under.

**Green** – There will be NO Green Fleet at this Regatta

- 3.2. and will close on Friday, Feb 14, 2020 at Midnight. Late registration is available at the registration desk between 0830 and 1030 Feb 15, 2020.
- 3.3. All competitors and coaches must check in at the registration desk between 0830 and 1030 on Saturday Feb 15, 2020.

#### 4. CLASSIFICATION

This regatta is open to all World Sailing Sailor Classifications.

#### 5. FEES

- 5.1 **On-line** registration fees are \$55 for singlehanded boats and \$110.00 for double-handed boats. Fees include Saturday and Sunday on-water snacks and Saturday dinner GST/PST. Extra Saturday dinner ticket: \$20
- 5.2 **Late registration** fees after Feb 14, 2020 are an **additional \$40/ boat** (\$95 and \$150).
- 5.3 Cancellation fees: a 50% processing fee will apply to all cancellations.

#### 6. SCHEDULE

**Saturday, February 16, 2019**

**0830 – 1030** – Registration and Check In

**1000** - Coaches Meeting by coaches for coaches lower lounge

**1015** – RC, Jury, Coaches and Support Boat meeting in lower lounge

- 1045 – Competitors meeting on RVYC foreshore
- 1200 – Warning signal for first race, except Optimists, subsequent races to follow
- 1230 – Warning signal for Optimists, subsequent races to follow
- 1700 – Coaches meeting in lower lounge (ASAP after racing finishes)
- 1800 (approx) – Dinner with Coach video debrief main lounge

### **Sunday, February 17, 2019**

- 1000 – Warning signal for the first race, **except** Optimists, subsequent races to follow
- 1030 – Warning signal for Optimists, subsequent races to follow

- No warning signal will be made after 1500 hrs.
- Sailors competing in the White Fleet shall compete on the water no more than 3.5 hours after the first start of the day. This is in accordance with a directive from BC Sailing.
- Prizes will be awarded on the lawn or in the Main Lounge approximately one hour after the last boat finishes.

## **7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing Instructions will be available on-line by February 10, 2020 and limited printed copies available Saturday February 15, 2020 between 0830 and 1030 at the regatta registration desk.

## **8. RACING AREA**

The regatta will take place in the vicinity of Cadboro Bay and Oak Bay as per Attachment “A”.

## **9. COURSES**

Courses will be as defined in the Sailing Instructions.

## **10. SAFETY**

Competitors shall wear a flotation device at all times while on the water, it may be removed briefly to adjust clothing. This changes Rule 40 and the preamble to Part 4. All boats **except Optimists** must carry a 15m long, minimum 7mm diameter, buoyant towline tied to the mast. **All Optimists** shall carry an 8m long buoyant line as per class rules.

## **11. PENALTY SYSTEM**

For ALL classes, rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns penalty is replaced by the One-Turn penalty.

## **12. SCORING**

**12.1.** One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

**12.2.** When fewer than 5 races have been completed; a boat’s series score will be the total of her race scores. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat’s series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst discard able score.

## **13. SUPPORT BOATS**

Coach and other support boats must be registered. Attendance at the Coaches meetings in the lower lounge of the clubhouse is mandatory. Failure to comply may result in a team penalty at the discretion of the Jury. Coaches are not restricted on the course. Coaches shall endeavor to not interfere with the racing but may coach during the event during races. This applies to all classes.

## **14. PRIZES**

Prizes will be defined upon closure of registration.

## **15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta and each race entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## 16. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with minimum third party liability coverage of \$300,000 USD for USA and non-Canadian residents and \$1,000,000 CAD for Canadian residents.
