RULES: The regatta will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing*. Changes in sailing instructions shall be made in writing before a race by posting in proper time on the official notice board. The office notice board is outside the CBYC clubhouse. Class rules shall apply.

ELIGIBILITY: This regatta is open to all OD boat members of SCYA or USSA recognized yacht clubs and must be members in good standing of their Class Association.

CLASSES: Cal 20 and Mercury with at least three entries in each class.

RACE SCHEDULE: Three races on Saturday and two races on Sunday are planned weather and time permitting. Three races completed, as a minimum, shall constitute the series. All races count toward the final score, no throw-out races. This changes *RRS* A2.1 The first warning signal of the day will be at 1225 hours. No race will start after 1500 hours on Sunday.

SAILORS MEETING: A sailors meeting will be held on Saturday November 14 at the CBYC Dry Storage yard at 1000 hours.

COURSES & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing instruction will be available at registration online, plus any posted supplements.

PROTESTS: Protests will be heard following each day of racing.

ENTRIES & FEES: Entries are online with Clubspot at the following website: <u>https://cbyc.org/regatta/YS9EfFH5HX</u> All entries must be filed prior to 1000 hours on race day. The entry fee is \$50.

LAUNCHING: Two hoists of up to 6,000 pounds capacity and a 14' wide dinghy ramp are available at the CBYC dry storage facility located along Via Cabrillo adjacent to the main clubhouse.

TROPHIES: Trophies will be awarded at the conclusion of the regatta, based on the entries.

ACTIVITIES: All participants shall comply with the latest COVID-19 Social Distancing requirements of the State, County, City and CBYC. All sailors and crew should use member/skipper keycards to enter a rear of club to access the downstairs restrooms (no entrance to Club's upstairs restrooms through front doors). If skippers plan to go or to invite their crew to visit the CBYC terrace, following the race, reservations should be made by calling the club: 310.519.1694. Please note that the club computers and staff will not be available for sailors to register or pay.
