

HYC SPRING REGATTA May 19, 2019 Hampton Yacht Club Hampton, Virginia

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020.
- **1.2 US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 63.2 and 63.4 will not apply.**
- **1.3 RRS Appendix V1 (Penalty at the Time of an Incident) will apply.**

2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to One-Design classes under 25', including Viper 640s, 505s, HODs,
- Lightnings, J-24s, Sonars, Melges 14s etc. To race, a fleet must have at least three (3) boats. 2.2 Boats may enter on Club Spot via the HYC website.
- Or, they may submit a CBYRA Standard Entry Form and check at Registration.
- 2.3 The Entry Fee is \$30 if paid by Friday, May 1. Entries received after that are \$40.
- 2.4 Free launch, haul, and boat/trailer storage is provided with multiple hoists available.

3. SCHEDULE

- 3.1 The regatta will consist of multiple windward/leeward races.
- 3.2 <u>Sunday, May 19</u>:
 - 0900 Registration/Check-In Opens (HYC Lounge)
 - 1000 Skippers Meeting (HYC Flagpole)
 - 1130 Warning Signal
 - ASAP after racing = Awards, Hot dogs and beer in the "Viper Pit".

Note: The 505 Fleet will race separately on Saturday with their own support boats.

4. COURSES

4.1 Multiple windward/leeward races will be attempted.

4.2 Courses will include offset marks and gates plus opposite start/finish line to ensure minimal waiting time between races.

5. RACING AREA

Off Hampton Flats approximately 1 nm SW of mouth of Hampton River (near mooring buoy).

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Printed S.I.s will be available at Registration and posted on the Notice Board.

6.2 Preliminary S.I.s will be posted electronically several days prior to the regatta.

6.3 Final fleets, class flags, and Order of Starts will be provided at the Skippers Meeting.

Preliminary, unofficial information may be posted at HYC and/or electronically prior to that.

7. SCORING & AWARDS

7.1 RRS Appendix A Low Point Scoring will be used

7.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

7.3 505 Fleet scores from Saturday will be included in their series score.

7.4 Appendix A2.1 is modified to say that each boat's series score shall be the total of all her race scores. There will be no throw-outs.

7.5 Awards will be presented in each fleet of at least three boats.

8. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
